Theme of the event: Pop and Rock

- 1. All bands wishing to register for the War of the Bands contest must read and accept the following rules and regulations before completing the registration form.
- 2. All bands must contain a minimum of three (3) members. However, all members must sign that they have read and understand the registration form. If you have any questions, please clear them up with the coordinator prior to signing the form.
- 3. Bands may bring one roadie to assist them with set-up and break-down and that person must also be listed on the registration form.
- 4. All band members are required to be present at least 30 minutes prior to performance time to check in with the coordinator. If all band members are not present and ready to set up for performance 15 minutes before going on stage, the band will be disqualified.
- 5. All participants are required to be courteous and respectful toward other participating musicians.

Equipment and Onstage Rules:

- 1. Participating band will have to bring their own equipment's, the college will not provide it.
- 2. Band members are responsible for the security of their equipment.
- 3. Each band will be given the opportunity to play live for 20 minutes' maximum.
- 4. While one band is playing, the next band may start getting ready to set up in the background. However, please do not be disruptive so that the band on stage can be the focus of the judges and the crowd.
